



Important announcement regarding changes to our club permit rules

From 1 June 2023, the Club will introduce 2 new provisions in respect to participation in our Club Permit Scheme. These changes are intended to meet the Club's obligations under Vic Road's requirements for the scheme.

The first change will apply **ONLY** to new cars joining the scheme – cars already on the register will not be impacted by this change and will continue to renew their permit as previously with just the addition of the new confirmation form shown under the heading "Change 2".

CHANGE 1 - APPLIES ONLY TO NEW VEHICLES JOINING THE SCHEME.

Prior to admittance to the scheme, each car will be required to be inspected and signed off as being suitable for inclusion in our register. **THIS INSPECTION DOES NOT TAKE THE PLACE OF THE REQUIRED ROADWORTHY CERTIFICATE – IT IS AN ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT.**

Initially there will be one metropolitan inspector and two regional options. These are:

This new provision is **IN ADDITION** to the existing requirements of:

- Current RWC
- Filled in Vic Roads form "Club Permit Application Form"
- Filled in Vic Roads form "Eligibility and standards declaration for Club Permit Vehicles"
- If car is modified, filled in Vic Roads form "Vehicles Assessment Signatory Scheme"
- Proof of Ownership – receipt of purchase or similar
- Six (6) photos (with date stamp visible in the photo) taken of the car as specified on the Club's web site
- A stamped, self-addressed envelope for return if posting the papers to the Club Permit Officer – Brian Aitken, 59 Sanders Road Frankston South VIC 3199 – 041 902 5858.

CHANGE 2 – APPLIES TO ALL PERMIT RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

A new form is to be included with each Permit Renewal submission, asking members to confirm that the vehicle has not in the previous 12 months been modified outside what is permitted in the Vehicle Standards or the Guidelines (VSI 8, VSI 33, VSI 4 or NHVR Code of Practice) - in other words, does not require a new permit for a modified or "M" plated vehicle.
